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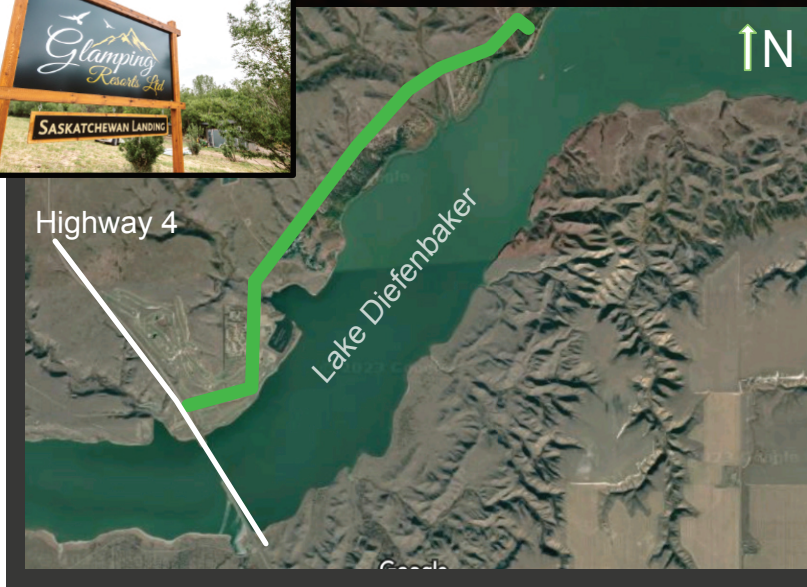


# How to Find Us

From Regina: Head west on the Trans Canada Highway until you reach Swift Current.  
Turn north on Highway 4 towards Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park.  
After crossing Lake Diefenbaker on Highway 4, turn right into the Park.

From Saskatoon: Head west on Highway 7 until you reach Rosetown.  
Turn south on Highway 4 towards Swift Current.  
Turn left at the Provincial Park entrance on the north side of Lake Diefenbaker.

After purchasing your park pass from the Park office, continue on the main road for approximately 5km.  
Once the road turns to gravel, the access to Glamping Resorts will be immediately on your right.  
The check-in office is to the left when you enter the resort.



## Day One

#### 6:00PM - BBQ Dinner

Fire up your personal BBQ and have a delicious dinner just outside your tent.

#### 8:00PM - Firepit and Sunsets
